Ms. Nirmala Giri recounts one of her most recent experiences with Sri Sri Swamiji —

Guruji asked me, "Should you not do your duty as a mother?"

I said, "Yes, Guruji, I should but"

Guruji who was sitting on the Mantap at the Ashram ready to do puja to Sri Premika Varadan-Madhuri Sakhi asked, "But what?"

I said, "I do not have a passport!" [I thought I had a point there and the matter would be dropped there!]

Guruji retorted, "That is not a big deal! Go right now to Bhagyanathan. He will guide you."

My daughter who lives in the United States was in the family way. As I had never had any intention of leaving the Indian soil at any point of time I had never applied for a passport. But Guruji who takes care of the needs of not just His devotees but also of their families is always strict that we do not fail in our duties. It is another of the Guru's doing that I got my passport quickly.

It was sometime in late September, when, on learning that I had got the passport Guruji said to me, "Right. Get the tickets!" I was taken aback. I told Him, "Guruji! This is only the passport. I am yet to get my visa. And, it takes six months to get the visa interview date.

I have got my passport only today. Even this morning when we checked out on the visa date we find the first available date is in the last week of March. Nisha is expected to deliver her baby early February. If at all I make it, it will be after a month and half late."

G simply said, "You are going to the U.S. and for six months."

In spite of long years of being with the Guru one fails to comprehend or appreciate His ways. I thought, 'this acquiring passport is sheer waste of money. Guruji, for some reason is adamant in sending me away. He does not understand what I say. He is not ready to listen to me.'

I wanted to do what He wished but at the same time the mind like an obstinate teenager wanted to do what it wanted.

Two days after getting the passport my sister called up from Bangalore to say, "Check the newspaper. I hear that the U.S. Commissioner at Delhi has announced early and more openings for the visa interview." And on checking we find that beginning October there were umpteen number of visa interview dates available! We could choose the date!

My husband looked at me with surprise writ large on his face. "How did this happen?"

I simply said, "Hmm! That is the way Guruji works! He has decided to pack me off to the U.S!" And, here I am in the United States taking care of the baby girl who took birth in a Texas hospital amidst the chanting of the Mahamantra

Hare Krishna Hare Krishna Krishna Krishna Hare!"

It needs no mention that when the Guru says 'six months' it will be 'six months' for, in spite of all my effort I could not get the return ticket a day early!

Fond Memories Of Bliss – Part 2

In the fertile Tanjore belt in Tamil Nadu, there is a town with historic significance called Gangaikonda Cholapuram. Once this was the glorious capital of the Chola kingdom. This town is sanctified and beautified by an ancient Shiva temple. The Shiva Lingam here is one of the rarest and one of the biggest, in terms of size. Another unique feature of this Lingam is the "Anna abhishekam" (Abhishekam with rice) that is performed by devotees on the Full moon day in the Tamil month of Aippasi. It is a grand and unique celebration.

On one of Sri Swamiji's visits to Kumbakonam several years ago, I had the good fortune of spending time in His divine company. One day, Sri Swamiji had a suddden 'divine call' to go to Gangai Kondacholapuram Shiva temple and off we were in no time. It appeared to me that Sri

Sri Swamiji was very intense all through the onward journey and as we entered the temple the intensity seemed to be maximal.

To a casual onlooker, it would appear that Sri Swamiji was in a restless state. To my utter amazement, Sri Sri Swamiji did the most unusual act. He ran quickly towards a big pillar in the mandapam (hall) and clasped it tightly with both arms. He was standing there holding on to the pillar for a while. At that time, His face wore the most unique expression. His entire body was radiant and quivering.

This lasted for a while and then Sri Swamiji slowly walked down to a secluded corner and sat with His eyes closed in deep meditative state. He was perfectly still in that meditative posture for what seemed like ages to me and finally He opened His eyes. We had darshan of the Lord and the Divine Mother.

I could hardly control myself as we began our return trip. I asked Sri Swamiji, "Swamiji! If I may ask you, will you kindly spell out what you were going through inside the temple? Why did you suddenly hold on to the pillar? Were you feeling giddy? I was very worried!"

Sri Swamiji replied smilingly 'As I entered the temple I suddenly started feeling that I was becoming lighter and that I would fly away. Slowly the intensity of the feeling increased and at one point I was so sure that I would fly away that I became afraid. I rushed to the pillar and grasped it tightly with all my energy. Only after it subsided, I let go!'. That was how Sri Swamiji described his most unique experience.

To this day, while talking about that temple, Sri Swamiji would jokingly remark, 'You know! I never go to that temple because I am afraid that I might fly away!'

Thirumoghur

As we continue to explore Sri Swamiji's compositions on various deities and kshetras, let us travel to Thirumoghur.

This divyadesam is in Madurai District, about 8 kms from Madurai in the madurai Meloor route. The presiding deity is Sri Kaalamega Perumal found in Nindra Thirukolam facing east. The Thayar is Moghur Valli or Mohana Valli. She has a separate sannidhi in the temple. One of the specialities of this temple is that, sudharsana Alwar is found with 16 hands with 16 different weapons. He is in "Prathaaleeha" position, which means a person running to help the bhaktas. Nammazhwar has song 11 Pasurams and Thirumangaiazhwar has sang 1 Pasuram in this temple.
