Tirupathi

As we continue to explore Sri Swamiji's compositions on various deities and kshetras, let us travel to Tirupathi.

Tirupati is a city in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. Its Sri Venkateswara Temple sits atop one of the 7 peaks of Tirumala Hills, attracting scores of Hindu pilgrims. Sri Venkateswara National Park, home to the temple, also contains the Sri Venkateswara Zoological Park with lions and primates. Nearby, next to a waterfall and cave believed to be sacred, Sri Kapileswara Swamy Temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva.

Bhaktha Charitra - Panduranga Bhaktas Series : Vishoba Keshar

The land of Pandharpur is ruled by Lord Vittoba. It is believed that Lord Vittoba has shown great fondness to Sants namely Gnaneshwar Maharaj, Namadev Maharaj, Muktha Bai, Jana Bai, Sennanayi, Tukaram Maharaj, Ekanath Maharaj and many more. Every devotee has a special place in Lord Pandurangan's Heart. Lord Pandurangan guided his devotees to become great Gnanis by leading them to a Guru.

Who is a Guru?

Guru is the one who leads us from darkness to light.

In Guru Geethai, God Shiva elaborates to Goddess Parvati about the significance of Guru in many shlokas. One such Shloka is

ध्यानमूलं गुरुर्मूर्तिः पूजामूलं गुरुर्पदम् । मन्त्रमूलं गुरुर्वाक्यं मोक्षमूलं गुरुर्कृपा ॥

Dhyana-Moolam Gurur-Murti Pooja-Moolam Gurur-Padam | Mantra-Moolam Guruur-Vakyam Moksha-Moolam Guruur-Kripaa ||

The above shloka means the root of meditation is Guru swaroopam. The root of worship is Guru's feet. The root of the mantra is Guru's words and the root of moksham is Guru's kripa.

As our Guru Maharaj always conveys, God always sends a Guru when we really wish to attain God.Likewise Lord Panduranga directed Sant Namadev Maharaj to attain a Guru, who was Vishoba Keshar.

Vishoba Keshar (or) Vishoba Chati was a jeweller by profession. He didn't have a very positive attitude towards Gnaneshwar Maharaj and his siblings as he thought they were distracting people. It was the month of Aippasi, the festival of Diwali was arriving. In Maharashtra during the festival of Diwali, a special sweet called mande is usually prepared. On the day of diwali, Nivrithi Dev (Gnaneshwar Maharaj's Brother) asked Muktha Bai (Gnaneshwar Maharaj's Sister) to prepare mande. Mande was supposed to be done on a specific earthenware (Mantoyentan). When Muktha Bai went to the market to buy it, she was interrupted by Vishoba Keshar who had already ordered the sellers not to sell any pot to Muktha Bai. Disheartened Muktha Bai returned home without buying a pot. Seeing sad Muktha Bai, Gnaneshwar Maharaj came forward to help her in preparing the Mande. Using his Yogic prowess, he produced yogic agni using his

sushumna, to prepare mande. Vishoba Keshar was witnessing the scene from the entrance of Gnaneshwar Maharaj's home. He was taken aback and instantly realised their spiritual state. He quickly ran to fetch a piece of the Mande, ate it as prasadam and attained Gnanam.

How did Vishoba Keshar become the Guru for Namdev Maharaj?

Once when Gnaneshwar Maharaj, Namadev Maharaj and a few other Sants were on a theertha yatra (pilgrimage tour), they made a visit to Sant Gorakhumbar's home. There was a stick-like thing hanging in Gorakhumbar's home. When Muktha Bai enquired about the stick, Gorakhumbar explained that it was used to check if a pot has completely baked by tapping on it. Muktha Bai playfully said she will test the bhagavathas there, if they were baked or non baked, which meant she was testing them to see if they have attained Gnanam. Namadev Maharaj, noticing this act, got angry thinking how could a small girl test his spiritual state. Muktha Bai tested out the stick on Namadev Maharaj and said he's non baked. Hearing this Namadev Maharaj got embarrassed and went running to Pandurangan. Pandurangan and Namadev Maharaj speak to each other as they loved each other to a great extent. Namadev Maharaj questioned Panduranga if Namadev Maharaj was unbaked. Lord Pandurangan replied "Yes!" telling "Talking to me is different but attaining Gnanam is different. Gnanam can be attained only through a Guru. I did this leela for you to attain Gnanam". Namadev Maharaj requested Lord Pandurangan to direct him to a Guru. Pandurangan directed him to "Vishoba Keshar" who was in the nearby forest. Namadev Maharaj rushed to the forest seeking his Guru.

In the forest Namadev Maharaj saw a sadhu who was resting his legs on a Shiva Linga. Shocked to see this behaviour, he questioned the sadhu and told him not to rest his legs on Shiva Linga. The sadhu requested Namadev Maharaj, to place his legs elsewhere. When Namadev Maharaj touched the sadhu's feet and placed it in another place, another Shiva Linga emerged from that place and again when he placed in another place there emerged a Shiva Linga. The entire place was surrounded by Shiva Lingas. Namadev Maharaj instantly realized the sadhu was no one else than his Guru Vishoba Keshar. Lord Pandurangan blessed Namadev Maharaj with his Darshan. With his Guru's grace, Namadev Maharaj attained the supreme Advaitha state.

Every human on earth will need a Guru to go through a correct Marga (Path) to attain the almighty. We pray to our Guru Maharaj to bless us all with Krishna bhakthi and attain the lotus feet of Lord Krishna.

Cherised Memoirs

This series chronicles interesting experiences recounted by the devotees of HH Maharanyam Sri Sri Muralidhara Swamiji. These articles are translations from the series, "Madhuramaana Mahaneeyar" that is published every month in Madhuramurali Tamil monthly magazine. Solace Amid the Floods!

Recently, torrential rains had shaken up the whole state of Tamil Nadu. It is said that after 1918, i.e., after nearly 100 years, there has been this kind of downpour. On December 1st and 2nd, of 2015, there was 50 cm of rain on just a single day. Water began to stagnate everywhere.

Lakes that provide water for Chennai city began to fill up fast. Yet the rains did not stop. Out of fear of the dams breaking down they were opened up. That was it! Like a river in spate water began to run all over the Chennai city. As water from the dam began to flow in great gush inside the city and also stagnate, the power supply was cut off. Telephone lines and cell phones stopped functioning. One cannot describe the grievous state of those in Chennai city. My Lord! How can one describe the state of those with infants, those that needed emergency medical care, those who needed assistance to move... Their sufferings beat all verbal descriptions! Electric trains did not run. All buses plying from Chennai to places outside were stopped. People were in deep distress. Those who had relatives and friends in Chennai were in deep distress as they could not contact them in anyway.

My own daughter lives in Salagramam area in Chennai city. Water had flowed into her house and they suffered for a week. There was no way of contacting her. I was deeply worried and became very restless. I did not know what to do.

At 8 pm one night I sat down and began to pray to Sri Swamiji. Until 1 am I continued to pray to Sri Swamiji while chanting Nama (the Divine Name).

It was then that suddenly Sri Swamiji appeared before me, just like I was seeing him in person. Sri Swamii said to me, "Do not worry! Your daughter is safe." His words were very clear. My mind began to calm down and I felt greatly relieved.

The next day around 2 pm there was a call from my daughter. She informed me, through her cell phone, that she and her family were safe.

I felt deeply touched by Sri Swamiji's grace and his reassuring words. I shared this experience of mine with all devotees in the next satsang in Thanjavur.
